MENTORING PLUS

Mentoring

Each child referred to the programme will receive up to ten one-to-one sessions with

a trained mentor. This will help vulnerable children with the opportunity to engage with positive, relatable role models and to enable them to make positive contributions to wider society.

In the mentoring sessions we explore issues of identity, friendship circles and belonging, and low self-esteem. We create a programme for each individual, and offer a progression route via our own programme of creative activities, or other local youth initiatives.

PLUS Social and Creative activities:

At Paddington Arts we run a weekly session of Dance and Drama for 6-10 year olds. If a child is referred to our programme, we can offer unlimited free classes; collect the child from school; short mentoring session (i.e. how did you get on today) at the end of the session. We also run a termly Milkshake Disco for 6-10 year olds, where children can socialise with their peers, and perform dance or singing if they want to.

PLUS Taster workshops in schools

We can offer up to 4 sessions in each school targeted at the whole class of the child on the Preventing Exclusion programme, so they do not feel singled out, and can make up their mind if this activity is something they would like to try again.

The workshops we offer are Dance; Drama; Photography; Video

LET'S DANCE NOT FIGHT

'Let's Dance Not Fight' is a commissioned piece of dance theatre, and a programme of outreach workshops aimed at young people from West London. We will

- · Promote youth dance across West London
- · Provide a showcase for diversity and excellence in youth dance
- · Make a stand against intolerance, hatred and violence
- · Give a platform to those (particularly young people) who have been affected by violence or intolerance and/or are campaigning against it In addition we will hold a Youth Dance weekend at Paddington Arts: the Saturday will be for rehearsals and masterclasses; the Sunday will be a performance. As part of this project we will work with five schools or community groups to create a dance piece that can contribute to our community festival. The young people who wish to come forward to talk about their personal experiences will be given a platform between performances. This will create an increased social awareness about the challenges faced by young people, and the steps they are taking to counteract these negative forces. At the same time, the

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL DAY AT CAMP INVOLVE?

A typical day at camp will involve a morning of training and practices based around a specific skill or technique such as dribbling, finishing or passing. This is followed by an afternoon of small-sided matches and

tournaments either side of a lunch break.

Children can wear trainers, astroturfs or football boots. In inclement weather we recommend layers, so that your child can take off/put on extra layers if they get too hot or cold.

aren't allowed to stay and watch except for the first 30 minutes of their child's first day at camp.

At Market Road, registration is 10am and collection is 3pm. WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS?
